

Traditional & Partial Denture Flow Chart

Pick up in the morning counts as first day in lab; pick up in afternoon counts as next day in lab

First Appointment:

* Take preliminary impressions to fabricate custom trays (three days in lab)

Second Appointment:

* Take master impression to fabricate baseplate and wax rim (two days in lab) or cast partial (four days in lab)

Third Appointment:

* Try in baseplate and wax rim or framework and take bite registration. Return for set-up (three days in lab)

Fourth Appointment:

* Try-in/Tooth try in and return for process (two days in lab)

Fifth Appointment:

* Insert full or partial denture.
