

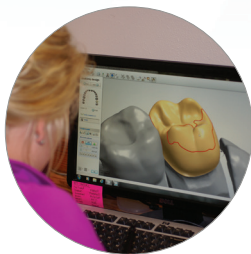

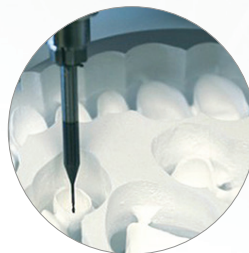
20+ Years of Technology Innovation

Began computer-aided design (CAD) of fixed restorations



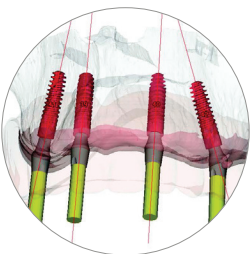
2001

2008
Began 3D printing investment patterns for partial denture frameworks
Received first digital impression from intra-oral scanner



2013
First year the majority of crowns produced in our lab were all-ceramic



2015
Became first authorized lab in Wisconsin to fabricate SIMPLANT surgical guides
Offered design and milling services to CEREC doctors



2018
Began milling splints and non-metal removable partial dentures
3D printing our own models from digital impressions



2019
First lab in Wisconsin to have Ivoclar Digital Denture Mill
Also have Carbon 3D printers to print digital dentures
