



Traditional vs Partial Denture Flow Chart

*** Pick up in the morning counts as first day in lab; pick up in the afternoon counts as next day in lab*

TRADITIONAL DENTURE

First Appointment

- Take preliminary impressions to fabricate custom trays (3 days in lab)

Second Appointment

- Take master impression to fabricate baseplate and wax rim (2 days in lab)

Third Appointment

- Try in baseplate and wax rim and take bite registration; return for set-up (7 days in lab)

Fourth Appointment

- Try-in/tooth try in and return for processing (4 days in lab)

Fifth Appointment

- Insert full denture

PRINT DENTURE

First Appointment

- Take preliminary impressions to fabricate baseplate and wax rim (2 days in lab)

Second Appointment

- Take bite registration using baseplate and wax rim and then take reline wash final impression inside the baseplate, using it as your custom tray (3 days in lab)

Third Appointment

- Try-in and return with any adjustment notes for printing (2 days in lab)

Fourth Appointment

- Insert full denture
