

# **Traditional vs Partial Denture Flow Chart**

\*\* Pick up in the morning counts as first day in lab; pick up in the afternoon counts as next day in lab

#### **TRADITIONAL DENTURE**

### **First Appointment**

• Take preliminary impressions to fabricate custom trays (3 days in lab)

### **Second Appointment**

• Take master impression to fabricate baseplate and wax rim (2 days in lab)

## **Third Appointment**

• Try in baseplate and wax rim and take bite registration; return for set-up (7 days in lab)

### **Fourth Appointment**

• Try-in/tooth try in and return for processing (4 days in lab)

### **Fifth Appointment**

• Insert full denture

## **PRINT DENTURE**

### **First Appointment**

• Take preliminary impressions to fabricate baseplate and wax rim (2 days in lab)

## **Second Appointment**

 Take bite registration using baseplate and wax rim and then take reline wash final impression inside the baseplate, using it as your custom tray (3 days in lab)

## **Third Appointment**

• Try-in and return with any adjustment notes for printing (2 days in lab)

## **Fourth Appointment**

Insert full denture
